MetroAction Hosts Free Energy Seminar for NEPA Businesses

SCRANTON – To commemorate Earth Day and bring awareness to how area businesses can position themselves to meet the current energy challenges, MetroAction will host a free seminar titled, "How to Prosper in the New Energy Future" on April 22, 2008 at 8:30 AM at MetroAction, 222 Mulberry Street, Scranton.
